

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MOTT CITY COUNCIL

September 12, 2011

The Council met for their regular scheduled meeting on September 12, 2011. Present were Mosbrucker, Steiner, Zich, Scheeler, Messmer, Wangsvick and Riedlinger. Also present for the meeting were Sheriff Warner, Jim Privatsky, Rod Landblom, Ron Friedt, Mark Resner and Kerry Mosbrucker. All motions are carried, unless otherwise stated.

The meeting was called to order and Messmer moved to approve the previous minutes as presented, seconded by Zich

Jim Privatsky, representing Kadrmas, Lee & Jackson was present to discuss the 2012 Street Improvement.

Zich moved and Scheeler seconded Rod Landblom's, representing Roosevelt-Custer Regional Council, proposal for the start of planning and updating of zoning. Lanblom also disussed where we were at with the FEMA buyout.

Sheriff Warner presented the police report. Riedlinger moved to approve the report, seconded by Messmer.

Zich moved and Scheeler seconded to transfer the amount from Special Assessments into the General fund and transfer from that fund into the Building/Armory fund.

Messmer moved and Zich seconded to close the St. Improvement fund and transfer the balance into the general fund.

Messmer moved and Scheeler seconded to approve the building permit for Sharon Schaible for renovating the inside of the prior Dakota Gunsmith building.

Steiner moved and Wangsvick seconded to appoint Duane Olson as the city assessor.

Riedlinger moved and Wangsvick seconded the police contract for 2012. Zich moved and Riedlinger seconded the Preliminary Budget.

Zich moved and Messmer seconded the selling of the W 100' of Lot 2, blk 16 of Mott Original to Duane Lutz.

Wangsvich moved and Messmer seconded to reject bid received form Karl & Karlyn Jantz for Lots 7-9, Blk 20 of Mott Original.

Messmer moved and Riedlinger seconded to change the employee handbook to allow employees to live within fifteen minutes of the city in order to work for the city.

Wangsvich moved and Zich seconded to hire Jim Stern for assistant city superintendent.

Steiner moved and Zich seconded buying mower from Don Schaible for \$4,000.00.

Zich moved to approve the 2nd reading, seconded by Steiner for: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 130416, CURFEW OF MINORS. (This was printed in the previous minutes).

Council discussed Corey Johnson's plumbing code violation and to proceed with turning it over to Sheriff's department for ordinance violation.
