

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MOTT CITY COUNCIL

April 9, 2012

The Comprehensive Planning & Zoning with Gene Buresh of Roosevelt-Custer Regional Council was canceled for this evening and will be resumed again next month at 7:30.

The Council met as a Board of Equalization on April 11, 2011 at 8:00 pm. Present were Mosbrucker, Steiner, Scheeler, Wangsvich, Riedlinger, Roy Steiner, County Auditor acting as city assessor, Devin Olson, Kurtis Burwick and Kerry Mosbrucker. No one appeared before the board with any discrepancies. Steiner said there will be no changes. Riedlinger moved to approve County Auditor, Roy Steiner's assessment as presented, seconded by Scheeler.

The Council met for their monthly scheduled meeting on April 9, 2012. Present were Mosbrucker, Steiner, Scheeler, Wangsvick and Riedlinger. Absent were Zich and Messmer. Also present for the meeting were Sheriff Warner, Deputy Josh Monson, Kurtis Burwick, Devin Olson, Gilbert Mehrer and Kerry Mosbrucker. All motions are carried, unless otherwise stated.

The meeting was called to order and Wangsvick moved to approve the previous minutes as presented, seconded by Scheeler.

Sheriff Warner gave the police report. Council discussed designated truck routes and obstruction of view of the streets when parking on them. Steiner moved to accept police report as given, seconded by Riedlinger.

Kerry Mosbrucker gave the superintendent report. He has been working with Kadrmas, Lee and Jackson to figure out sewer and water line placements for the construction of the apartments and a house being moved in W. Mott and they recently tore a house down on lot 7, Blk 7 of Mott Original.

Council read a letter from a resident not liking our new policy of no vacation rates. Council mentioned that if he comes before council and shows that it is a hardship, they may look into it more, but it will stand as is until then.

Riedlinger moved and Steiner seconded the **2<sup>nd</sup> reading of AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ZONING DISTRICT MAP**, (printed in previous minutes) that will change the Timber Creek Properties area from R1 designation to R2, for multi-family dwelling. Roll call was taken, all voted "aye". Carried.

Steiner moved and Scheeler seconded to have city attorney write a letter for the city that they are not in favor of the application for appropriation of water by Vernon Mayer.

Wangsvick moved Riedlinger seconded the approval of the raffle permit for the Taylor-Skartvedt American Legion Post #71.

Steiner moved and Scheeler seconded to give the Mott Library one hundred dollars to utilize for the summer reading program.

Bids were opened for Lot 7, Blk 7, Mott Original. Wangsvick moved and Scheeler seconded the bid received from Daxton Kirschmann.

Spring clean-up week will be May 6<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup>. Council will have their spring tour of the city prior to meetings next month. Auditor is to put an ad in the paper. Appliances will be free to drop off, but not those that need the Freon taken out, unless they have the appliance tagged stating as such.

Gilbert Mehrer was present to discuss moving his trailer that is currently in the Park District's campground to his lot in W. Mott. He will put it there until he gets it cleaned out and will then move it out of W. Mott.
