

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MOTT CITY COUNCIL
September 10th, 2012

The Council met for their monthly scheduled meeting on September 10th, 2012. Present were Mosbrucker, Steiner, Zich, Johnson, Wangsvick, Messmer and Riedlinger. Also present for the meeting were Sheriff Warner, Kurtis Burwick, Paul Peltier and Kerry Mosbrucker. All motions are carried, unless otherwise stated.

The meeting was called to order and Messmer moved to approve the previous minutes as presented, seconded by Wangsvick.

Hettinger County Agent, Dwain Marxin wanted to check with the city if it would be possible to look into the area of the prior Gary Schlosser home that the city purchased through the flood buyout program for use of a shooting range for 4H.

Sheriff Warner gave the police report. She told council that the trees on the corner of 3rd Street and Illinois are making it hard to see and asked about the possibility of getting a yield sign in the area.

Discussion was held on Nuisance Complaint received, in which the auditor will send a letter for clean-up of property. Steiner moved to accept police report as given, seconded by Wangsvick.

The Law Enforcement Service Agreement for 2013 was presented. Wangsvick moved to approve seconded by Messmer.

Kerry Mosbrucker gave the Superintendent report. He stated that the status of the flood buyout of home demolition is close to complete. Mosbrucker mentioned that a new mower deck is needed for one of the mowers. With the price of a mower deck versus getting a new mower, K. Mosbrucker was told to see if he could find a mower.

Messmer moved and Zich seconded to clean the water way out by the Nursing Home.

Council reviewed the Preliminary Budget. Zich moved to approve, seconded by Steiner.

Riedlinger moved and Johnson seconded the approval for the Mott/Regent application for annual Bingo/Raffle Permit.

The following building permits were presented: #1739 Richard Bergerson-window, #1740 George Buress-concrete slab, #1741 Michael Cline-fence, #1742 Doug Wegh-Sunroom, #1743 Stan Blickensderfer-garage, #1744 Slope-Hettinger SCD-concrete in building. Upon building inspector review of applications, Messmer moved to approve, seconded by Riedlinger.
