

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MOTT CITY COUNCIL

August 9, 2016

The Council met for their monthly scheduled meeting on Monday, August 9th, 2016. Present were Mayor Mosbrucker, Council members Messmer, Steiner, Johnson, Quamme, Riedlinger, Wangsvick, and City Superintendent Mosbrucker. Also present was Sheriff Warner and Lori Eggers. All motions are carried, unless otherwise stated.

Wangsvick moved and Steiner seconded the approval of the July Minutes.

Riedlinger moved and Quamme seconded the approval of the City's police report. Investigations in July included 2 deaths, animal abuse, dogs at large, arrest warrant, and a driving under suspension. A revised 2016 police contract was signed by the Mayor and Auditor showing the change to 160 patrol hours per month.

City Superintendent Mosbrucker reported that the storm drain project was completed. Also several gate valves needed replacement. Additionally, there is some curb stop repair work that is needed in the 500 block of Iowa.

The City received a request from the school to help haul and pile up gravel. More information is needed but the City will help will help dependent on other City projects.

Some street repair is needed after recent water breaks. The city will collect some quotes on repair work.

The Cemetery would like to put up a light by the flagpole. All the work for the project has been donated and Johnson moved while Steiner seconded the approval of the City taking on the month electricity charge for the light which should run approx. \$25.00 per month.

Preliminary 2017 budget was presented. The council will review over the next month. Finalization is scheduled for the next Council meeting, September 12th.

Steiner moved and Quamme seconded the approval of the Altar Societies Raffle Permit.
