

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MOTT CITY COUNCIL

June 13, 2016

The Council met for their monthly scheduled meeting on Monday, June 13th, 2016. Present were Mayor Mosbrucker, Council members Messmer, Steiner, Johnson, Riedlinger, Wangsvick, and City Superintendent Mosbrucker. Absent was Michelle Quamme. Also present was Deputy Kaul and Lori Eggers. All motions are carried, unless otherwise stated.

Messmer moved and Wangsvick seconded the approval of the May Minutes.

Steiner moved and Johnson seconded the approval of the Police Report as reported by Deputy Kaul. Investigations in May included vandalism, 2 thefts of property, harassment, suspicious person, stolen vehicle, warrant service, harassment/credit card fraud, suspicious activity in the high school.

City Superintendent Mosbrucker shared the water tower had been drained, cleaned and inspected. It was suggested that at the 2018 inspection we replace a valve and do a little repair work. The city will budget \$9000 in the 2018 budget to do the suggested work. They are just about done spraying sidewalks and gutters for weeds. The health inspection of the sewer system went well with only a screen that needs replacing being noted.

Steiner moved and Riedlinger seconded the approval of the final application for the High Schools CDBG grant.

Johnson moved and Steiner seconded denying Betty Rude's tax abatement request.

Letters need to go out to homeowners regarding the state of their home/property. Complaints have been received.

The Mayor shared that the Armory was struck by lightning on Saturday (6/11) night. There is a section of roof on the west side of the peak that needs repair. Also the electrical in that same area was affected.
