

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MOTT CITY COUNCIL

November 14, 2016

The Council met for their monthly scheduled meeting on Monday, November 14th, 2016. Present were Mayor Mosbrucker, Council members Steiner, Johnson, Quamme, Riedlinger, Wangsvick, and City Superintendent Mosbrucker. Council member Messmer was absent. Also present was Sheriff Warner, Viola LaFontain, Geno Sloan, Kelly Anderson, Connie Anderson and Lori Eggers. All motions are carried, unless otherwise stated.

Wangsvick moved and Riedlinger seconded the approval of the October Minutes.

Johnson moved and Quamme seconded accepting the police report as presented by Sheriff Warner. Investigations in October included Domestic, a suicidal individual, drugs, resisting arrest, and providing false information to an officer.

School Superintendent LaFontain was on hand to discuss their CDBG grant through Roosevelt-Custer Regional Council. Originally the grant was to put an elevator in the high school. Since the new Elementary school is being constructed, it was cheaper to include an elevator in those plans. With the help of Roosevelt-Custer, the school was able to change the CDBG grant to fix the chair lifts and make all the interior high school doors handicap accessible. Johnson moved and Steiner seconded the continued support and sponsorship of the City for the amended grant.

The TOPS group has been taking care of Pioneer park and it's member can no longer continue that maintenance. Geno Sloan came to the City to ask for assistance. Mayor Mosbrucker said he would meet with the Park Board and possibly the Vo-Ag teacher to see if there is any support available.

Kelly and Connie Anderson came to ask the City to reconsider creating an ordinance that would allow minor's to eat in bars with a parent or guardian. The Council will ask for a legal opinion on the matter (NDCC 05-02-6-C) and further discussion will happen at the December meeting. Also, Bottom's Up would like to offer live music, but the band in question has minors as members. The City will research if the minors are allowed in the bar when part of a band.

Superintendent Mosbrucker reported the school project has had some extra asphalt the the city workers were able to use to do some street repair. The city purchased a used packer to aid in street repairs. A shut off was repaired on 500 block of Indiana. Also the Library door needed some extensive repair. Wangsvick moved and Johnson seconded the purchase of the packer.

City Sales Tax revenue was reported as trending very closely to the 2015 and 2014 numbers.

Riedlinger moved and Johnson seconded the approval of the bills as presented:
