

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MOTT CITY COUNCIL
September 12, 2016

The Council met for their monthly scheduled meeting on Monday, September 12th, 2016. Present were Mayor Mosbrucker, Council members Messmer, Steiner, Johnson, Quamme, Riedlinger, Wangsvick, and City Superintendent Mosbrucker. Also present was Sheriff Warner, Deputy Cude and Lori Eggers. All motions are carried, unless otherwise stated.

Wangsvick moved and Riedlinger seconded the approval of the August Minutes.

Superintendent Mosbrucker reported that they have been busy helping out with the Fire Hall renovation and the new school project. The Airport's road project has been completed and there was some leftover asphalt that the city was able to use to do some patch work. Talk of the alleyway between the Kindt and Hawn houses needs a gutter. The City will request an estimate.

Sheriff Warner presented a 2017 Police Contract. Steiner moved and Riedlinger seconded approving the contract for \$72,384 for 160 hours per month. The ½ of 1% county sales tax will not start dispersing money until approximately the first of June. Messmer moved and Johnson seconded the approval of the police report for August which included the following investigations: Suspicious activity, missing person, domestic x 3, accident, theft of property, death, restraining order violation, gas drive off, and trespassing.

Messmer moved and Wangsvick seconded the appointment of Owen Blickensderfer to the airport board to replace Dr. Gjerstad.

Wangsvick moved and Johnson seconded the City bringing water lines up to the new addition's curb stop, provided the school district will do the necessary street repair work. The estimate is \$4700, labor to come out of Surge fund and materials out of Curb Stop fund.

Messmer moved and Steiner seconded sponsoring a "Scrub Camp" for freshmen and sophomores put on by the West River Medical Foundation to promote careers in the healthcare field. The \$500 sponsorship will come the Economic Development fund.

Messmer moved and Quamme seconded the approval of the 2017 revised preliminary Budget. Final vote on the budget will be through a special meeting on 10/3 at 7:00 pm.

Wangsvick moved and Riedlinger seconded the approval of the bills as presented:
