

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MOTT CITY COUNCIL

June 12, 2017

The Council met for their monthly scheduled meeting on Monday, June 12th, 2017. Present were Mayor Mosbrucker, Council members Messmer, Wangsvick, Johnson, Steiner, Quamme and Superintendent Mosbrucker. Riedlinger was absent. Also present was Jody Messmer, Sheriff Warner and Lori Eggers. All motions are carried, unless otherwise stated.

Messmer moved and Wangsvick seconded the approval of the May Minutes.

Wangsvick moved and Quamme seconded the approval of the police report as presented by Sheriff Warner. The investigations included tampering with US mail, domestic violence, simple assault, terrorizing, and vandalism.

Superintendent Mosbrucker shared the tarring was complete except for three block around the school. Patching will begin shortly. Also they have been busy mowing the lagoon and cleaning up the Oscar Rodgers property.

Jody Messmer requested street/alley closure for a July 3rd party. Steiner moved and Johnson seconded approving the request.

The Mayor updated the Council on our CDBG grant application for the ADA shower at the Armory. In September Roosevelt-Custer will be notified how much money is available for the grants. The Mott request is #2 on the list so there is a good likelihood the City will receive funds.

Roger Senn is retiring from the Armory effective 6/30/17. The school is advertising for a replacement. The Mayor and a Council member will help with the interview process.

The City received a complaint against Councilmen Johnson. Upon further review, this is not a City issue, and Council informed Mr. Johnson that it needs to be resolved between him and the other party privately.

Messmer moved and Wangsvick seconded the approval of Raffle permits for the Fair Association and the Mott Country Club.
