Messmer moved and Wangsvick seconded the approval of the September Minutes.

Riedlinger moved and Quamme seconded the approval of the police report as presented by Deputy Kaul. The investigations included disorderly conduct, trespassing, harassment, and vandalism.

Superintendent Mosbrucker and city worker Zentner have been busy patching streets and still have a few more patches to make in West Mott. They need to order more hot mix to finish the job. The new city shop is painted and the guys have started moving equipment in. The bobcat needs to go to Bismarck for service, it's been locking up while driving.
