

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MOTT CITY COUNCIL
September 11, 2017

The Council met for their monthly scheduled meeting on Monday, September 11th, 2017. Present were Mayor Mosbrucker, Council members Messmer, Wangsvick, Johnson, Steiner, Riedlinger, Quamme and Superintendent Mosbrucker. Also present was Sheriff Warner and Lori Eggers. All motions are carried, unless otherwise stated.

Wangsvick moved and Riedlinger seconded the approval of the August Minutes.

Johnson moved and Wangsvick seconded the approval of the police report as presented by Sheriff Warner. The investigations included driving under suspension, fraud, vandalism, domestic assault, theft of property, and harassment.

Superintendent Mosbrucker and city worker Zentner have been busy patching streets and still have a few more patches to make in West Mott. The lagoon passed inspection and can be drained. They've also been working on the memorial in the park.

Shed bids were opened. Wangsvick moved and Steiner seconded the sale of shed #1 to Jan and Darrell Ottmar for \$2260. Messmer moved and Wangsvick seconded the sale of shed #2 to Jeremy and Holly Ottmar for \$2175. Messmer moved and Riedlinger seconded the sale of shed #3 to Jan and Darrell Ottmar for \$1751. Messmer moved and Quamme seconded the sale of shed #4 to Jeremy and Holly Ottmar for \$1775. Wangsvick moved and Riedlinger seconded the sale of shed #5 to Kelly Grist for \$1310.

Preliminary Budget was reviewed and will be finalized at the October 9th meeting. It is available for review at City Hall.

Old Armory lockers are being offered for use to the Fire Department. If they don't want them, they will be offered to the City of Regent.

The building at the City's yard needs some brickwork. The plan is to find a mason to inspect and see what can be done. Stucco covering the building may be an option.

There will be a public hearing on September 21st at 10am at City Hall for the CDBG grant. Steiner moved and Riedlinger seconded that if there is no objection to the grant that the final application be signed and submitted.
