

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE MOTT CITY COUNCIL**  
**February 12, 2018**

The Council met for their monthly scheduled meeting on Monday, February 12th, 2018. Present were Mayor Mosbrucker, Council members Messmer, Wangsvick, Johnson, Steiner, Riedlinger, Quamme and Superintendent Mosbrucker. Also present were Sarah Warner, Josh Bullinger, Seth and Kristen Forester. All motions are carried, unless otherwise stated.

Wangsvick moved and Johnson seconded the approval of the January 2018 minutes.

Riedlinger moved and Wangsvick seconded the approval of the police report as presented by Sheriff Warner. Investigations in January included, a death, 24/7 violation, domestics, and disorderly conduct. The Sheriff also shared we are losing two deputies.

Superintendent Mosbrucker shared a report on our water tower and the work that needs to be done. The estimate from Maguire Iron was approx. \$80,000. The City is working on some additional quotes for the work. Also the back end went out on the white pick-up. It has been repaired.

Josh Bullinger is interested in building a shooting range. He wanted to see if that was something he could do within City limits. The City Attorney will be consulted as to the City's Ordinances, but the City offered to work with Josh.

Wangsvick moved and Steiner seconded accepted the bid from Ellingson's for the creation of a second locker room and showers at the armory. The bid was for \$44,415 + \$1110 performance bond.

Mayor Mosbrucker, Council members Wangsvick and Steiner, and Auditor Steinke met with members of the school to review the bid for the armory work as well as a user agreement. Auditor Steinke shared the proposed changes to the User Agreement with the Council. Those changes will be forwarded to the City Attorney.

Steiner moved and Riedlinger seconded the approval of Raffle Permits #335 for the Mott-Regent School, and #336 for Mott Volunteer Fire Brigade.

MDU is leaving Mott and the New England office will be available for service calls and emergencies. The City is working with MDU to possibly create a bill drop-off elsewhere in the city for our residents. Plans to be finalized as soon as possible.
